The Brown Act sets forth the open meeting requirements for local legislative bodies in California. Amendments to the act have changed the requirements for mailing meeting agendas to interested persons. Effective January 1, 1998, California Government Code §54954.1 provides that “...Any requests for mailed copied of agendas or agenda packets shall be valid for the calendar year in which it is filed, and must be renewed following January 1, of each year...”
